October is here, and that means that it is time for our annual Fall Festival! This is my favorite activity of the year because so many families come to enjoy this community event and tradition. The Fall Festival will be held on October 18 from 6:00-8:30. Kristin Burrows and M'lissa Caines are in charge of the Stakeholders Committee, which will be planning the festival. Union Elementary is one of two schools in the county participating in the Out-Teach program. This is professional development for six of our teachers to learning about experiential learning and teaching outside, although all teachers will have access to a database of resources and lesson plans. Being that Union is located in a rural area with lots of farming, teaching about the environment and learning outdoors is the perfect opportunity for us. This program will help our students as they transition to middle school since East Union has a focus on agriculture. Our goal is to clean up the courtyard area. We would like to turn this into an outdoor classroom space with gardens, birdhouses, and weather instruments. Elementary schools in UCPS will be on a nine-week grading period this year instead of a six-week grading period as in previous years. This is a time to meet with your child's teacher to learn about how he is performing so far, what his strengths and areas needing improvement might be, and to discuss any questions that you have. As the year continues, teachers typically will have additional conferences with parents if they have concerns about the child's academics or behavior. However, please know that you are welcome to call, email, or request conference with your child's teacher at any point during the year.
