<u>About PRHS</u> - Porter Ridge High School is one of eleven public high schools in Union County, North Carolina. Porter Ridge has a 2023-2024 student population of approximately 1750. PRHS opened in 2005 and graduated its first senior class in 2007. PRHS is fully accredited by AdvancED. PRHS provides a strong college preparatory environment with 80% of the senior class attending a two-year college or four-year University. PRHS participates in Leader in ME, which is a whole school improvement model that uses teaching practices to promote social and emotional learning for students.

<u>Schedule</u> - PRHS operates in a 4 x 4 block schedule with PRHS students receiving instruction in four ninety-minute classes each semester. Some classes are taught on an A/B day schedule with students taking one class on A day and another on B day. Students have the opportunity to earn 8 credits per year for a total of 32 credits in four years of high school.

<u>Diploma Requirements</u> - Students must earn 28 credits for graduation (one credit per class). Students who transfer in must meet maximum potential minus 4 which may result in in fewer than 28 credits.

<u>Pass/Fail</u> – Each year, students have the opportunity to take one elective course not required for graduation as a Pass/Fail. A course taken as a P/F will not be factored into the student's cumulative GPA.

<u>Class Rank</u> - All students eligible to be in the class are ranked each semester on the weighted cumulative grade point average using only the final course grade.

<u>Advanced Placement Courses</u> – Courses with a * are AP courses that are connected with a mandatory fall honors course, making it a two-course commitment. Other AP Courses operate on an A/B day schedule.

Online Courses – Students in all grades have the opportunity to take online courses through Union County Virtual (UCV) and/or North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS.) Online courses are utilized when courses are not offered face-to-face at Porter Ridge High School, when scheduling is an issue. UCV and NCVPS both offer CP, Honors and AP courses.

<u>Career and College Promise Program</u> – PRHS has partnered with South Piedmont Community College to offer college level courses through the Career and College Promise (CCP) program. Juniors and seniors have the opportunity to take community college classes through this dual enrollment program. Transferable CCP courses are weighted as AP level courses for weighted GPA purposes.
