Devices will be available for daily checkout for these students but should not be taken home. Fees for student Chromebooks are \$303.00 and \$25.00 for power supplies.		Cyberbullying will not be tolerated.
		• Students should not try to bypass the district filter in any way. This includes, but is not limited to, the use of proxy avoidance sites.
		* The student is to take reasonable care and use of these devices. Any abuse or repairs for neglect will be the financial responsibility of the student.
