Over the past few months, Mrs. Kraftson as worked with representatives from each grade level. Time was spent on understanding the purpose behind a vision statement, mission statement and core values. Once the why and what of this initiative was established, each representative brought back feedback from their teams. The representatives along with administration then began to create brand new core values, a brand new mission statement and vision statement.

Mrs. Kraftson shared the work of the committee. Feedback was given-specifically in regards to providing perspective stakeholders with a background of the "why" of this work and the meaning behind "The Weddington Way".

The Site Base Team voted on the new mission, vision and core values. All members voted to approve the revisions.
