Agenda Item IV: Voting on Policy Changes

- Discipline Policy Changes: The Student Code of Conduct has been changed. The former Level B and Level C have been combined into Level B and item #14 was added. The consequences can be any that are listed, they are not ordered.
 - Vote: All in Favor
- Dress Code Changes: New: "Students who do not meet the dress code will spend the day in ISS"

Changes in the Dress Code for Girls:

- Shirts must have a sleeve and cover the chest, midriff, shoulder and undergarments at all times.
- Top shirt must not be a tank top, sleeveless, camisole or spaghetti strap, tube top or strapless shirt. Tube tops or strapless shirts are not allowed even when covered by another garment. Tank tops, sleeveless shirts, camisoles or spaghetti strap shirts can be worn but must be covered with a shirt that covers the shoulder.
- Tops must not be deep plunging.
- o Tops cannot be see through, have open backs or slits exposing bare back
- Shorts can be 2" above the knee
- Vote: All in Favor
- Bullying Plan:
 - School Bullying Policy
 - must follow UCPS Guidelines and Definition
 - one time is inappropriate, repeated instances equates to bullying
 - zero tolerance in UCPS
 - schools can use discretion for first offense
 - consequences change with repeated offenses
 - School Plan
 - individuals and small groups that meet with administrators and/or guidance
 - referrals from parents, teachers, etc.
 - students with known former issues with a student are typically separated as long as the school is aware there is a problem
 - pit talks address bullying thorughout the year

- schools looks into all reports
- consequences are decided by UCPS and cannot be changed at the school level
- Parent Inquiry
 - are coaches that coach booster club sports trained in regard to the bullying plan?
 - Mr. Nesteruk with share the bullying plan at the booster club meeting on Monday, 9/15
- Technology and Bullying
 - very hard to track, if a message, post etc. contains any indication of something happening at school or on school grounds the school can dig deeper - will be turned over to the SRO if needed
 - teachers need to discuss the importance of keeping usernames and passwords private and not leaving the laptops logged on
