- Portable Classrooms (furniture, transitions, electronics, landscaping, emergency drills) PTSO helped with electronics (TVs, Mounts, and landscaping needs
- Bigger classes average 30 per class
- 74 Additional Lockers should be here soon, cost about \$8,000 county will reimburse
- Cafeteria Capacity we are close to capacity—need to start thinking about master schedule next year
- Larger Staff, New Staff (Communication, Orientation)
- School Structure (1 Counselor and 1 Admin per Grade) positive feedback on structure (1 AP and 1 Counselor per grade)
