| Introductions of members and selection of chair - Attendees went around the room and introduced themselves. - Danielle Hill was elected as the sited based committee chair. | Hoover | 5 min |
| Review of SIP changes Dr. Hoover has made some changes to the SIP. Once test scores are in, the school goals need to be revised. Advanced Ed accreditation has sent some data that has led Dr. Hoover to set new goals. -Advanced Ed didn't see an organized system to run PLCs. PLCs now meet formally and informally to constantly collaborate. The goal is to use data to make instructional decisions based on students' needs. -Another change involves county school goal. | Plan for possible additional position There is a teacher position available for the school. - Possible allocations for this new position could be adding one more teacher to a grade level that is large, like 7 th grade. - Another possibility is getting Mrs. Nelson back to East Union. She would help with translations and communications with parents. - The third choice is for a full time tutor that would tutor students in the school throughout the year. | Dress code request Parents have approached Ms. Hyatt wondering if there could be some flexibility with dress code pants. Is it possible to give the option of navy pants? The question came about because there are many girls who have accidents with their pants. Dr. Hoover explained that this has been addressed at other schools with the same dress code as EU. A teacher explained that, if a girl has an accident during school, she's going to have to change pants whether the student is wearing khaki or navy pants. So there really is no point in allowing navy pants at school. There is the possibility of changing the color of pants to any tone of brown. 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| <p>Approval of draft budget</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The funding that used to go to summer school was given to school to use to remediate struggling students during the school year. - Special projects are money based on the student population that is below grade level. It will be used for programs and activities that help students academically. -State funds are allocated for buying items for the school. - County funds have more flexibility and can be used for tutoring etc. - Dr. Hoover presented the budget allocated for each school department. All departments had cuts. - Dr. Hoover is considering offering tutoring during the school day instead of at the end of the day. Students are tired at the end of the day and attendance has been dropping over the past two years. Tutoring in the afternoons is not helping students as much as it is intended to do. One idea may be hiring part time tutors to work during the school day with students. - Copier budget might seem large but this is something we need to have to function as a school. The money allocated is right. -Staff development has received minor cuts. School won't be able to afford everything to accommodate teachers that are out attending professional development. Some money from the staff development pot is going to be put aside for the summer science camp. - There are some reserves that the school has collected with pictures, dances and other events the school has. - The school is keeping the program RTI is using to track student's progress. <p>This is the budget so far.
