## Topics/Issues/Concerns

- Ms. Whitley opened the meeting by taking roll and providing the agenda
- *Read Across America* has been moved from Wednesday to Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup>
- It was brought to the team that the cafeteria is not being cleaned up by each grade level
- Mrs. Thomas informed the group that the top three budget needs (requested by Dr. Ellis) are: teacher salaries, teacher assistants, and a flex position (schools discretion)
- Fairview voted and the budget results are: teacher raises, flex position, teacher assistants
- Mrs. Thomas informed the group that Union County is losing teachers to South Carolina, Mecklenberg County, Texas and other surrounding states

- The flooding in the playground is getting worse – Can mulch be added around the benches in the grass to help cut down on the flooding?
- Mrs. Thomas informed the group that the county has looked at installing a drainage ditch on the playground to eliminate the flooding
- The group discussed the viability of having a morning KAT club
- The team discussed changing the morning holding routine in the morning to free up teachers to help with *Keeping in All Together* (3-5) club
- Mrs. Thomas decided to shelve the KAT club idea until it can be further explored (logistics)
- Ms. Whitley asked each grade level to provide a list of students who would benefit from the KAT club
- Mrs. Walker feels that parent support is need for buy-in to the KAT club
- Mrs. Evans mentioned that we should reach out to the community for additional homework/tutoring help – create a schedule for volunteers
- All grade levels voted “NO” to eliminating the holding tank in the morning
- Due to the unanimous vote of “NO” the KAT club is officially shelved until next year
- Mrs. Thomas requested that each teacher wear their employee ID badge
- Ms. Melton informed that group that Shiloh and Walter Bicket Elementary will be visiting FVES to present their successes with PBIS and Conscious Discipline
