**Action Taken:**

1. A Day/B Day- Which Classes...One parent stated that she liked the A/B day. She requested that we increase the amount of classes that are offered each day. We discussed that at this point, it is policy. Mrs. Giocondi explained how this concept did not work in Math as there were too many days in between lessons

so the students did not retain the information and that each day it cost time to reteach. Another parent stated that her student, who is a strong math student asked for her classes to go back to semester long, so the information is retainable.
