- i. Reviewed and approved December meeting minutes
- ii. Revisit of Graduation Cord for CTE Concentrators / ACT WorkKeys students Graduation committee wanted Site-Base to be able to justify their approval of the new cord, but not allow that approval to open the door for all clubs/groups to add graduation cords. Site-base discussed the pros and cons of having a cord for CTE concentration students, where most cords are given only to Honor societies. Decision was made to go with colored pins for students to wear on the lanyard of the medallion; further research is needed to see if a concentration in CTE is part of an Honor society nationally.
- iii. Ted-Talk Friday, January 29 during 1st and 2nd block. PTSO will provide refreshments. Each presenter is allowed four student guests and two adult guests. All presentations will be taped for viewing at a later time. Teachers are invited to visit as time allows.
- iv. Exam/NC Final Update * All tests for which there is an NC Final will be used by all schools in NC next year. There will be no continuing opportunity to "waive" out of using the state-made test to use a teacher-made test, which is what we currently do for some English courses and several Social Studies courses. Please communicate this change in your next departmental meeting.
- v. Semester Transition Updates
 - Early Graduates 20, finished after first semester
 - SPCC/Dual Enrollment approx 20 students
 - Co-ops/Internships approx 15 students
 - Flex Day program approx 75 students
 - Student schedule changes through Jan 28 (5th day)
 - Clarification to staff regarding student schedule changes what are the parameters and circumstances that exist that allow students to make these schedule changes
 - Teacher schedule changes through Feb 4 (10th day)
- vi. Spring Registration Process for 2016-17
 - Timelines and related processes will be developed and communicated in February (to include teacher recommendation process - will plan to use PowerSchool again for as much as possible)

- Will be meeting with MRMS reps on Feb. 10 to prepare for meetings and processes with 8th grade student and families
- To increase lines of communication between 8th grade teachers and 9th grade teachers, we were able to have a luncheon on a recent teacher workday with reps from English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Guidance and Admin from each school meeting together to discuss matters relevant to the high school transition process.
- vii. International Baccalaureate Program Applications Open for 2018
 - January 25 through February 9 is the application window
 - Teacher recommendations are very important part of the application and acceptance process.
 - Mr Jones explained that recommendations are not so much used to refuse admittance, but to give the IB teacher a snapshot of the student that is coming forward, and to use that information to plan classes
