- iv. School Improvement Goal Follow-up
  - suggestions for connecting to those students that were identified as needing more intentional advocacy:
    - have last year's teachers look at those same names to see if there were relationships formed in previous years
    - o bottom line is to have strong relationships with our students
    - have to be careful about identifying students; moral and ethical dilemmas
    - instead of contacting individual students try to change the climate of the school
    - start with the teachers and support staff for climate change

- survey
  - o use another term for "adult advocate"; teacher/coach/guidance
  - o use a yes/no questionnaire; short
  - option to identify the supporting adult
  - o need students' names; anonymous won't work
  - o need to explain to students why the school is asking for this information
- after in depth discussion, survey may not be the best idea for connecting with students
- have all staff members be more cognizant of their interactions with all students
- Needs Assessment survey data will be used to evaluate further necessary actions (Guidance Department is continuing to tweak the Needs Assessment based on feedback from the district staff)

## v. Academic Options Session Reflection

• Ms Shrader felt the session was well received; Ms Ennis stated it was very informative; the panels were a great addition; attendance was lower than previous years
