<p>Realignment/School Choice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Powerpoint was sent out April 6th - using in today's meeting <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Finalized maps based on BOE decision ○ Biggest change is there will not be a letter sent to tell who has a new assignment, parents/students must go to the map and enter their address and learn their new assignment. ○ Scribbles (online) system/process site - put information in to be considered for Grandfathering ○ Updated transportation system with assignments for 2018-19 ○ Since the March 6th BOE vote staff: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Worked with Matt Cropper to add new features to maps that will give the 2018-19 assignments ○ Connect-ed will go out tonight (4/9) on steps for accessing the realignment information. ○ Scribbles is made available 4/10 to parents <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Will be posted to reassignment website ■ Declare as early as possible to be grandfathered in - this will help the school and you get your slot. ○ Not sure percentages so far for Piedmont <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ A lot of Monroe kids will be brought here ○ School choice is only available if there is capacity - once a school meets or goes over it is off the table ○ Laptops will be available in school offices to provide access to Scribbles for parents ○ Parents will need child's student ID # to access information in Scribbles and submit requests for grandfathering and transfers. ○ Grandfathering requests will NOT be accepted after April 23rd 11:59 pm ○ <i>Beginning</i> May 1st - parents will be notified of grandfathering placement ○ May 9th - schools begin communication about clubs, athletics, parent organizations, etc. ○ May 14th - transfer period begins for renewal applications ○ June 1 - transfer period begins for any applications (school choice) 	<p>Tyson</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ June 25 - parents notified about decisions related to transfer applications ● Dr. Tyson believes we will be under 90% capacity ● Capt. Werder - should we advertise? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Answer: school choice helps because it helps students compete and helps fight against the Charter and Private schools getting the funding/\$ and benefits financially the public education ○ This is the BOE way to assist bringing students back to public education. ● Unionville rep - believes school will stay same #s wise ● Fairview rep - #'s may be down ● Transportation is the real key to where students will go ● If a student is registered and wants to stay, they stay because of grandfathering but they must provide transportation ● Parking - selling to seniors first <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Lottery for juniors if there are spaces
