<p>Pulsera Project</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● International club and FL raise money for Nicaragua ← Approved       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ It was done last year during International week - advertised at the Festival but not sold.</li> <li>○ Bracelets made by artists and sold.</li> <li>○ Proceeds go to the foundation to assist artists with College and employment.</li> <li>○ Co-founder "Cycle of poverty is maintained by the inability to plan for the future."</li> <li>○ Artists are trained to make and sell which gives them a trade, they can pay for college and there are employment opportunities.</li> <li>○ Mr. Tiller is planning to visit in 2019</li> <li>○ Going to ask Unionville about selling at the festival</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Tiller
<p>Student Assignment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● UCPS did approve the assignment</li> <li>● Students are going to be moved</li> <li>● Community - slow down and wait because there are amendments that were voted on and there are so many items that are not current online yet.       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Be sure to pay attention to correct maps - different levels have different maps (Elementary, Middle, High).</li> <li>○ Maps have glitches so be mindful in case there are errors.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● April 1st - tentative when BOE will begin mailing out new assignments.       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ It will articulate if you want Grandfathering.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● School choice has been voted in and approved.       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ School under 90% capacity - students can apply to go to those schools.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Tyson

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Piedmont is currently under capacity so this is an option.</li> <li>○ Grandfathering will go first - then the choice will take effect.</li> <li>○ Choice will be lottery style.</li> <li>○ Choice may not take place until the following year.</li> <li>○ Teachers can send their children anywhere they choose in UCPS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Only apply once per school.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● We do not know if transportation will be provided for certain clusters requesting but it is being asked.</li> <li>● Core Capacity: We can take 1600 at Piedmont <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Teaching allocation depends on the amount of students that come</li> <li>○ Enrollment will probably increase next year but may decrease in the future</li> <li>○ Teaching assignments will stay the same.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Around October - there will be people who decide the traveling in the morning is not going to work out and those students can transfer back to their home-school. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ This might affect teachers - we will have to see</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Parking has been publicized - this can also be an issue - we will see as it goes.</li> </ul>
