Transfer Procedures

Human Resources Superintendent Dr Harris has noticed a lot of issues in relation to transfer procedures. Here are the guidelines for teachers. The transfer list comes out in March/April? Teacher transfer must be on the transfer list by the appropriate due dates from June 1st to August 1st. If your name is not on the list you will not be granted a transfer. A teacher must communicate with their supervisor their intention of transferring. The teacher must interview for the position they are applying for.Principals must not contact a candidate unless the existing principal has been contacted. The final deadline is August 1st, transfers will only be considered under extenuating circumstances. Check the UCPS website for BOE policy for further information.
