Call to Order Old Business New Business

- a) Feedback, Cafeteria, recess, car line: A new table has been purchased for the cafeteria. Outside picnic tables will be ready next week. Encourage grade level teachers to advise parents where they can sit. There has been an influx of parents at lunch and as we keep going this will lighten up. Friday's are also a busy day. Keep parents at their designated tables or four outside at the picnic tables. "Pick a friend" in the cafeteria is not happening for the rest of the year. What are the guidelines for outside food? They can bring outside food. Be mindful of the parents eating outside and we cannot prop any doors open. They will need to rely on staff walking in the hallway to let them back in.
- b) Recess: Ms Earp has had feedback from three grade levels for consideration. There will be a bucket for all equipment to be kept under the awning. (Eg: tic tac toe etc.) for the painted activities. Ms Jobe will be collecting all classroom P E recess baskets to replenish the PE equipment cart (there is one cart per hall). Be mindful to collect PE equipment at the end of recess. There needs to be roles assigned to students and staff to collect equipment.
