- Defined Stem Presentation: Medlin presented information about Defined Stem.

 content, STEM content, and real-world applications including career pathways.

 - 3-5 Choose from Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies and do one activity by the end of this school year. Holland suggested that using it as a culminating activity works best.

- EC During the recent practice fire drill there were book bags outside of the doors
 when their class was leaving for the drill. Mrs. Earp said if students have book bags
 dropped off before dismissal because the students are at Specials, the book bags

- Parents Xcel2Fitness uses a grassy area outside during the club's practice. There are
 a lot of fire ants. Mr. Watts said the areas were sprayed this week. Mr. Watts will walk
 the area and put in work orders if there are additional spots to be treated. Mrs. Earp
 asked teachers to report any concerns to office staff so work orders can be entered.
- Guidance Do we want to do the Snowflake Tree for Poplin families in need this year? If so, Glahn needs to get information out soon. Mrs. Earp asked for members to talk to their team and let Glahn know if they are in support of it. Parent members/PTA were in support.
- PTA Concerning teacher reimbursement requests, reimbursements guidelines are:
 Certified staff (\$200) and Classified staff (\$100). Next year PTA plans to tweak guidelines for reimbursements.
- Administration There was damage from Hurricane Florence on some of the fencing around the school. After working with insurance, quotes should be available soon and it will be repaired. The area is near property line to Wise Acres. Again no doors should ever be propped open. Maintenance is working on the software issues controlling our HVAC system. This is also a concern with doors being propped open. Also during monthly safety audits, UCSO is documenting any safety issues per school. Mrs. Earp asked how members share information discussed at our meetings with their team. Mrs. Earp asked members to share information as soon as possible. There will be checks to make sure you don't have any unacceptable appliances in classrooms soon. Just FYI, there are two classrooms which require refrigerators because of diabetic needs. Please check your classroom to make sure it is compliant and refer to list of acceptable appliances given at the beginning of the year. Please make sure to send your video for Terrific Kids to Medlin by 10/19/18. As of today Medlin has only received three videos. Also make sure if you haven't to share the student's name and form for Terrific Kids back to Mrs. Glahn. Blue bins in classrooms will be for recycling.
