 - Benson: 73%, moved from a C to a B; we were 1/10 away from exceeding growth.

 - GL = Grade Level
 - Reading
 - 3rd Grade 44.8 CCR, 57.6 GL
 - 4th Grade 38.0 CCR, 52.2 GL

- 5th Grade 51.8 CCR, 66.3 GL
- Math
 - 3rd Grade 67.8 CCR, 82.8 GL
 - 4th Grade 48.9 CCR, 54.3 GL
 - 5th Grade 86.7 CCR, 89.2 GL
- Science
 - 5th Grade 85.5 CCR, 91.6 GL
- Reading was recognized as an area where improvement is needed. Team has recognized we have already begun this from Day 1 in our instruction this year.
- BOG results: 36% of 3rd graders are already at/ above grade level
