

Site-Based Committee Meeting

The Site-based committee met on Wednesday February 24, 2010 at Stallings Elementary.

First item discussed was the social committee. Each grade level discussed this committee and how it could be improved. It was decided that the dues should be lowered to \$20.00. The question arose as to what if people do not pay? It was hoped they would participate with the revamping of the committee and the lowering of the dues. Also, next year when dues are due – each grade level chair will be in charge of collecting the money from each teacher in their grade. They will turn this money in to the social committee. It was also decided to divide the committee into two parts. The social committee will now plan social events for the staff such as bowling nights, Christmas party, etc. A second component to be known as the “sunshine committee” will send cards, flowers, etc to ill staff and their family members, etc. There will be a staff meeting in March to present the changes to the staff.
