UCPS Bond 2016 Project

SVHS - \$24,364,734 with \$3,654,710 in soft costs

Three Architectural Firms have been recommended to create presentations and share those proposals with the Project Advisory Team on Monday, December 5.

Proposed Timeline for Project:

- Design Phase: Jan 2017-Jan 2018
- Bid Phase: February 2018 - March 2018
- Construction Phase: April 2018 - October 2019

Proposed Bond Projects for Sun Valley:

- Adding additional classrooms
- Auditorium renovations
- New athletic stadium
- Expand administrative office area,
- Add teach workrooms
- Expand cafeteria and kitchen
- Expand and update media center
- New chorus room
- HVAC and plumbing upgrades
- ADA renovations
- Remove/Repurpose mobile units
- Increase student capacity to 1,800

The construction will be completed in phases, which will take approximately 18 months. Students will be in the building for 14 months of the construction.
