This is a special meeting called to discuss fundraisers for Relay for Life.

The goal for Relay for Life (according to the website when you register) is \$100 per person. In the past we've had bake sales, extra jean passes, etc.

Pam Chaney: The event is April 29 at Sun Valley High School at 6:00. Many people walk earlier than that. Our site will be in the curve (#13) very near the gate. No one stays overnight anymore. We are not allowed. It is over at midnight, so maybe we shouldn't put up too much since we have to leave by midnight. Each group is responsible for bringing a basket or something to auction off. We collect can goods for the luminary bags. These will be taken to the homeless shelter after the event. Groups are encouraged to have an on-site fundraiser but we are not planning to do that. We will be selling "cupcakes" for the fundraiser to be displayed in the hallway. Mr. Hinson will make a big cupcake for the display. The little cupcakes will be \$1.00 for students to purchase. They will be left in the hallway to be displayed for a while.

Dr. VonCannon: The mock relay for students will be during C-SPAM on April 29.

We also have forms if students are purchasing the luminaries to be displayed at the Sun Valley event. They are \$10 each.

The can food will be collected from Monday, April 18 through Tuesday, April 26. Ms. Chaney will take the cans to her meeting that night.

Unionville staff will wear the salmon Unionville shirts to the Sun Valley event.

Suggestions from grade levels:

Kindergarten- Baskets like last year; jars with the teachers' pictures and names for change collected.

First Grade – same with jars, but the teacher would get a pie in the face; flip flop day, electronics days, sell Krispy Kreme doughnuts to the staff for \$1 each in the mornings.

Second Grade – Themed baskets and jean passes.

3rd, 4th, 5th Grade – same as above

C-SPAM – Crazy/radical jeans pass (for example \$100 for the rest of the year); Cards created by art club and sold for \$2 each.

Other ideas – baked good auction will be on April 20.

Dr. VC – She's willing to offer a "radical jeans pass" for \$100 for the rest of the year. Also, she'll offer \$5 jeans passes for April.
