- Ordering for 5th grade students The Tiger Rising. This is a gift to the students and the first read aloud for the year. Students can use all year long and use it to take notes and reference during the year.
- Also ordering a book about small group instruction for staff. Wendy will do a book study.
- Better Learning Through Structured Teaching: A Gradual Release for the responsibility of learning is also a book we may use for a book study. A guest speaker will speak on this topic in one of the early August staff development sessions. This will strengthen our small group reading groups.
- Also we've been looking at expense for tutors and TAs. Some of this money may be used to hire an extra certified teacher to teach students in younger grades to be proactive and help these students early. She would use the LLI program. This would be part of our special projects plan, which is aimed at at-risk students. Later, we can use bbq money to hire tutors to help students who are still struggling.
- Team meetings should include discussion about student progress. Intervention meetings are important and student recommendations should be dealt with early.
- We need to preview the student agenda and correct any mistakes before it is sent to the printers.
- The last day of school traffic was a problem. We need new signage to clarify the expectations for the two front lanes in the front of the school so that traffic can still pass through.
