



Request for Approval of Lawful Educational Absence

The Public School Laws of North Carolina require compulsory attendance for all children between the ages of seven and sixteen years (General Statute 115C-378). Every parent or person having control of a child between these ages enrolled in the Union County Public Schools is responsible by law to make sure the child attends school on a regular basis during the time school is in session.

According to Union County Public Schools' high school attendance policy, "credit will not be granted for classes when absences for a student reach 8 days for a semester-long course and 15 days for a year-long course." All absences will be coded unexcused unless a lawful excuse note is received in the office within three days after the student returns to school.

To request that an absence be considered as lawful and educational, this form must be completed by the student's parent/guardian and filed with the principal at least five school days prior to the day of absence.

Students will be required to submit a report summarizing the educational experience and impact of the educational opportunity. Length of report is one page per approved day absent and must be submitted within 5 days upon return. This report does not void the absences, but allows for the absences to be considered lawful. This report does not replace any course assignments.
