### School Parking Regulations

- 1. Parking a vehicle on campus is considered a privilege for students. Each student who drives must buy his/her own parking tag. Students may NOT park on campus without a tag, you will be ticketed. Students may NOT share tags. Parking tags are NOT transferable. If a student no longer needs a tag, it must be turned in to the administration.**
2. The school is not responsible for damage to private vehicles. All vehicles must be licensed and covered by insurance. School administration will not mediate any disputes arising from vehicle accidents. It is the student's responsibility to report any such accident to the NC Highway Patrol immediately.
3. It should be understood that video cameras are used to monitor the parking lots for safety reasons. All vehicles parked on campus may be subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion to believe that drugs, alcohol, or other contraband might be present in the vehicle. Drug dogs may be brought on campus and in the parking lots at any time. Any contraband discovered in the vehicle driven on campus by a student is considered to be in the possession of that student. Any other occupants of the vehicle may also face disciplinary action.
- 4. Parking tags are to be displayed everyday while on campus. The tags are to be displayed in the lower left corner of the front windshield. Vehicles will be ticketed for not having tag displayed. Violations are \$10 for each ticket up to the fourth ticket. The fourth violation will result in a \$20 ticket. A parking boot may also be utilized. Suspension of parking privileges for a period of time may also be given. Repeated violations will result in a permanent loss of parking privileges. If you park on campus without purchasing a tag, a \$25 ticket will be issued for each violation. Repeated violations may result in any of the consequences described in #11 below. Students may also lose the privilege to purchase a tag in the future.**
5. Students may not park in any area of campus besides the parking lot they have been assigned to unless approved by the administrators. Violation of this may result in suspension of parking privileges. Spaces will NOT be assigned this year. Students will be assigned a specific lot to park in depending on class level, schedule, etc. and the designated lots will be filled in as students arrive to school. **You MUST display the parking tag to park in the assigned lot.**
6. There will be no speeding or reckless driving (including spinning tires) on school campus (including Piedmont School Road). The speed limit on campus is 5 miles per hour.
7. Students must follow the designated traffic patterns and must not drive on any area which is not within these traffic patterns. Students seen driving cross grassy areas, across medians, around barriers or in other unauthorized areas will have their parking privilege suspended.
8. Driving another student off campus who has not legally checked out in the front office will result in suspension of parking privileges as well as disciplinary action.
- 9. Loitering or cruising in parking lots is not allowed. Once students arrive on campus, they must sign out at the front office to leave again.**
- 10. Students who have accumulated three to five lockouts/tardies to first block in a semester will lose their parking privilege for five school days. Students who accumulate six to eight tardies in a semester will lose parking privileges for 10 school days. Students who accumulate more than eight tardies in a semester will lose their parking privileges for the remainder of the semester. No refunds will be given.**
11. Additional rules and procedures are in the Student Handbook. **Students who drive to school agree to follow all rules governing driving to and parking on school campus.** These rules will be strictly enforced. Monetary fines (as described in the handbook), suspension of driving privileges, towing, and suspension from school may be imposed when violations occur.
