



All photos need to be received at CATA by October 31st. You can either send digital copies of photos or bring in print copies that we will scan for you. The highest resolution of digital file possible is best so we have options for resizing, etc. A dot per inch (dpi) number of 600 is good. Most home printer/ scanners will allow you to adjust the default scanning resolution. The main photo must be from the current year and feature the student alone. Tribute Sizes:

1/4 = \$100, 3 pictures max

1/2 = \$195, 6 pictures max

- <u>Students may choose their parking spot number if they purchase BEFORE the first day of school.</u>
  After that we will sell remaining spots in order.
- If you pay with cash, you MUST have exact change.

Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a waiting list. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive. We will have a waitlist for those students bringing in all appropriate documentation. We have 14 spaces left.
