



Student Parking Passes

ALL past due student fees must be paid before you are permitted to purchase a parking pass—this includes the 2015-2016, 2016-2017, AND 2017-2018 technology fee, media center fees, cafeteria, and any fees owed to CATA.

- ALL Students, MUST print and bring ALL required documents with you along with the cash (exact amount) or check for \$40 made payable to Central Academy of Technology & Arts. Any incomplete application packets will delay the process and you canNOT reserve your parking spot until all documents and check are turned in. Please make sure to have your parent sign the registration forms. They are available on the CATA website under "Students". Click here for the link.
- <u>Students may choose their parking spot number if they purchase BEFORE the first day of school.</u>
 After that we will sell remaining spots in order.
- If you pay with cash, you MUST have exact change.

Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a waiting list. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive. We will have a waitlist for those students bringing in all appropriate documentation. We have no spaces left and students will now be put on a waiting list.

Cougar Pride - Way to go!!!

The Civil Engineering Competition at UNCC last Friday was fantastic! The competition consists of (5) pre-engineering students per team competing in four categories: Geotechnical (soils), Environmental (water filtration), Structural (bridge design/build) and Transportation. There were four school districts represented at the competition this year. The top three places received recognition in each category, plus a judge's award for Best Geotechnical Design. Out of 13 possible awards CATA won 10!

Environmental – 1st, 2nd & 3rd places **Geotechnical** – 1st, 2nd & 3rd places and judges award for Best Design (swept all awards in this category 2 years in a row) **Structural** – 1st & 2nd places **Transportation** – 3rd place

The BI students will present their innovative ideas for the Engineering students, and faculty members based on completion of the collaboration

Our **2A State Wrestling Champions** were recognized by the City of Monroe and the Union County Public Schools Board of Education this past week.










