

The PSAT will be given 10/10/18 to ALL 10th graders and 11th graders who scored within the 90th percentile when they took the PSAT in 10th grade.

JUNIORS—All juniors will be taking the **ACT**, a college entrance exam on 2/27/19. In order to best prepare all juniors will work on **ACT preparation** during Cougar Time two times per week.



STUDENTS WHO DRIVE TO SCHOOL ON THE FIRST DAY WILL NEED TO HAVE A HANG TAG TO PARK IN A RESERVED SPACE. Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a waiting list. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive.
