Describe briefly how your efforts to serve your community have been effective and/or made a difference; 3. Express your future plans, education, and career goals and aspirations in life; 4. List extracurricular activities, jobs, hobbies, etc.; 5. Describe briefly why you feel the four qualities of a DAR Good Citizen (dependability, service, leadership, patriotism) are important and how you have tried to exhibit those qualities in your life and in your relationships with others. You must also include a transcript and two letters of recommendation from an adult who is not a family member. An optional essay portion is provided for students who would like to be considered for a scholarship at the state level. If you are interested in this award and scholarship please complete an interest form and return it to Ms. Cole by September 28, 2018. Amount: \$250-\$5,000. **Deadline: September 28, 2018.**

Class Information from the Guidance Counselors

The **PSAT** will be given 10/10/18 to ALL 10th graders and 11th graders who scored within the 90th percentile when they took the PSAT in 10th grade.

The **PreACT** will be on Friday, October 26th during 1st and 2nd block for ALL 10 grade students. The PreACT is a practice ACT and will help to predict how well you will perform on the actual ACT.

JUNIORS—All juniors will be taking the **ACT**, a college entrance exam on 2/20/19. In order to best prepare all juniors will work on **ACT preparation** during Cougar Time two times per week.

There is an **SAT prep course at CATA**. The course begins on Wednesday, September 26th starting at 4:30. The course will be held every Wednesday until October 31st with a practice test on Saturday, October 27th.

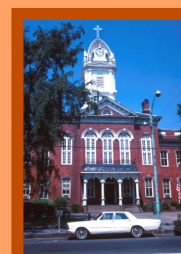

Know that if you write a long message that you may have to eliminate one or more photos. The yearbook staff will work with you to design the best tribute to recognize your senior. You can order senior tributes online as well using the URL above. If you don't see the option to order a tribute/ad, turn off any pop up blockers you might have on your browser and reload the page. All photos need to be received at CATA by October 31st. You can either send digital copies of photos or bring in print copies that we will scan for you. The highest resolution of digital file possible is best so we have options for resizing, etc. A dot per inch (dpi) number of 600 is good. Most home printer/scanners will allow you to adjust the default scanning resolution. The main photo must be from the current year and feature the student alone.

1/4 = \$100, 3 pictures max

1/2 = \$195, 6 pictures max

Full page = \$295, 9 pictures max

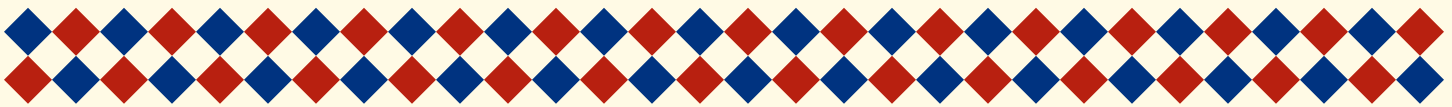

Student Parking Passes

ALL past due student fees must be paid before you are permitted to purchase a parking pass—this includes the 2015-2016, 2016-2017, AND 2017-2018 technology fee, media center fees, cafeteria, and any fees owed to CATA.

- ALL Students, **MUST** print and bring ALL required documents with you along with the cash (exact amount) or check for **\$40** made payable to Central Academy of Technology & Arts. Any incomplete application packets will delay the process and you **canNOT** reserve your parking spot until all documents and check are turned in. Please make sure to have your parent sign the registration forms. They are available on the CATA web-site under "Students". [Click here for the link.](#)
- Students may choose their parking spot number if they purchase BEFORE the first day of school. After that we will sell remaining spots in order.
- **If you pay with cash, you MUST have exact change.**

Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a waiting list. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive. We will have a waitlist for those students bringing in all appropriate documentation. We have 18 spaces left.

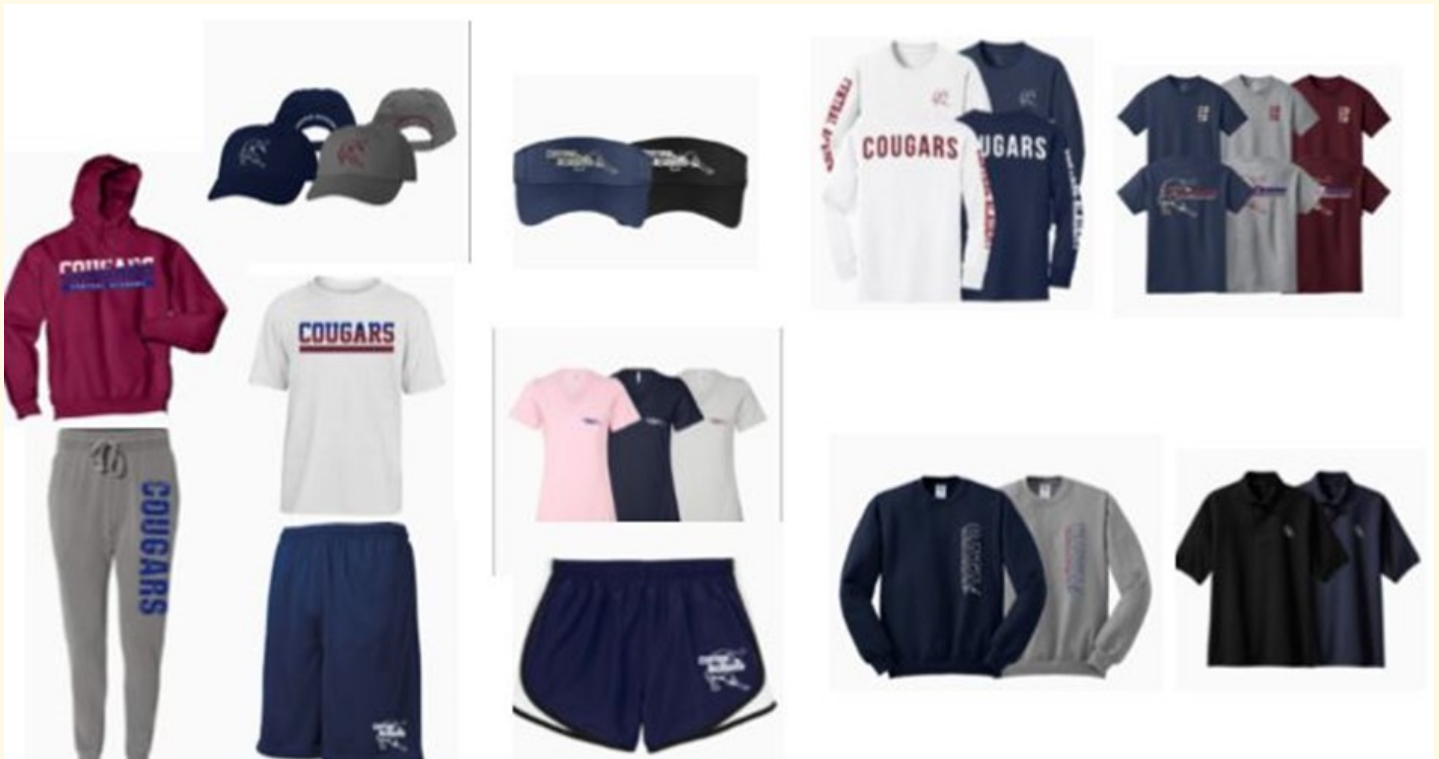

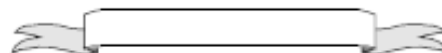
