- ◆ **Avery Pardue**, Sophomore, CATA student and **Taekwondo Martial Arts** contender just returned from the French Open. She was one of thousands contenders from across the world. She was one of seven US contenders and the only female from North Carolina. Avery won a 3rd Place Medal overall after beating France, Spain and Italy Taekwondo contenders. Avery has competed in the US Open twice and won a Gold Medal in 2018 and a Bronze in 2017. Congratulations Avery!
