<u>Change Canvas Display for Students:</u> Many students are in "List View," which only shows classes that have a due date on assignments for the day, therefore, students think there is nothing to do in some classes and are not getting credit for assignments. All students are asked to change this setting to "Card View" so they will see all four classes daily and are forced to go into each class for daily work. <u>Click here</u> for directions on how to make the change.

Spring 2020 COVID (Numerical Grade/PC19) Grade Correction Form: All grades for the 19-20 school are stored in PowerSchool. **STUDENTS**, please login into Power School and review your final grades from Spring 2020. To do this click Grade History - click 19.20 school year - then review your A2 final grades. By default, the grade choice impacting GPA in a positive manner was entered. Students, if a grade different than the one finalized in Power School is preferred, <u>click here to request a change</u>. You only need to fill out this form if you prefer a different grade option than what is showing. If you choose numeric average, you are choosing the higher of T4 or T4/T5 average as your final grade. The final day to process this request is Weds., **9/30 at 5:00 pm**. Please let your assigned School Counselor know if you have any questions.

<u>11th graders that are eligible for the PSAT</u> this year received an email directly from Ms. Lawson on Tuesday, August 25th. The PSAT will be given to the selected 11th grade students on **Wednesday**, **10/14** beginning at 9:00 am. To be eligible to take the PSAT this year you must have earned within the 90th percentile on the PSAT your 10th grade year (score of 1170). **No 10th graders will be taking the PSAT this school year**. If you have any questions or concerns please reach out to Ms. Lawson.

Attendance will be taken for student participation on their assigned day at school and virtually each day in Power School. School is in session and students are expected



to be in class or logged into a class session at the appropriate time each day unless otherwise stated.

Parking Passes One cannot drive and park at the school if they have not purchased a parking pass. Parking in any lot other than the student parking lot is not permitted. The process for purchasing parking pass is on FamilyID this



year, an account will need to be created if you do not already have one. <u>Click here for</u> <u>FamilyID</u>. Parking passes MAY NOT be purchased by any student who has outstanding fees. After completion of the application, CATA will review your submission. The student will then receive a link to pay for the pass once the application has been approved via student UCPS email. Parking passes are \$45. If you have any questions, please email Mrs. <u>Andrea Nahum</u>. Bus Info: Parents should email <u>Ms. Tweed</u> if they need bus transportation. Bus rid-



ers and parents should sign up for the Here Comes the Bus App. This app allows you to view the real-time location of your child's school bus on your smartphone, tablet or computer. Be sure that your child is a their bus stop at least 20 minutes before the scheduled arrival time. Bus App Letter English Bus

Attendance and Absence Notes:

Absence notes must be **emailed** and/or scanned to





data manager upon the student's return to school in order for the absence to be considered excused. Absences will be coded unexcused in PowerSchool until an email excuse is received. Please allow 24 hours for excusal notes to be coded in PowerSchool. Students may fail if they have 8 or more unexcused absences per class. Attendance is taken each class period. Students will have a chance to recover some unexcused absences.

Bell Schedule, Lunches, Expectations for Daily Learning

School Time- 9:05-3:45

1st period 9:05 to 10:35 2nd Period 10:40 to 12:10

3rd Period 12:15 to 2:10 (Your third period teacher will tell you the lunch time)

Lunch (one person to a table sitting facing the auditorium, café, small café, outside) Approximately 50 students in each lunch distanced in line.

Lunch Schedules and Times may vary and are subject to change

A Lunch 12:20 to 12:50

B Lunch 1:00 to 1:30

C Lunch 1:40 to 2:10

4th Period 2:15 to 3:45

Students will come to school once a week from Monday to Thursday and Friday will be an online learning day for all.

Students with last names A-D will attend school on Mondays, students with last names E-K will attend on Tuesdays, students with last names L-Q will attend on Wednesdays, students with last names R-Z will attend on Thursdays, and ALL students will participate in remote learning on Fridays.

Friday Schedule: Each student must check in with their teachers on Friday. The Friday schedule will look different than Monday thru Thursday. Each teacher has been asked to communicate with students the expectations for each Friday. Attendance is taken on Friday so students must complete the assigned tasks for each teacher to be counted present. This information should be posted on each teacher Canvas page.

- **10:40 to 12:10:** Complete Activities/ Assignments for 2nd Block Class (may include live or on-demand teacher instruction)

Lunch based on the time you would eat lunch at school during third block.

- 12:15 to 2:10: Complete Activities/ Assignments for 3rd Block Class (may include live or on-demand teacher instruction). Take note of the time your teacher would have scheduled for lunch.
- 2:15 to 3:45: Complete Activities/ Assignments for 4th Block Class (may include live or on-demand teacher instruction)



School Protocols Safety Click <u>here</u> for state Guidelines

Each teacher will answer health screening questions and have their temperature taken each day.

Each student must answer a series of health questions and have their temperature taken each day.

If your child is sick or exhibiting the following symptoms then please do not send them to school. 1. Fever of 100.4 or above

- 2. New cough
- 3. New trouble breathing, shortness of breath or severe wheezing
- 4. New Chills

5. New Muscle Aches

- 6. Sore Throat
- 7. Diarrhea

8. New loss of smell, taste, or change in taste

9. Have been within 6 feet of a person with a lab confirmed case of the current novel virus for at least fifteen minutes, or had direct contact with their mucus or saliva, in the past 14 days 10. These protocols may also call for additional measures to be put in place based on future guidelines.

Please do not come to school if you are awaiting a test result for the current novel virus or are living with someone who has the virus even if you have tested negative. Learn remotely until your family member is cleared.

We will have a separate nurses station for students who exhibit symptoms at school.

Everyone at school must wear a mask and keep physical distance of six feet apart or more. Students will be provide washable masks they must keep clean and can wear their own masks. Our hallways will have a marked one way walking pattern

Student desks will be sanitized and students will rotate the desks and work stations used.

UCPS will provide masks that are washable

Students are encouraged to bring their own personal hand sanitizer

Students may not enter the building until 8:35 AM

All students will go directly to their first period classes

A student may eat breakfast but will be distanced in line and in the dining area.

We will have distancing measures for the line and eating at lunch.

We will dismiss by car rider, bus rider, and student driver and students must exit the building.
