

MRHS Back To School Updates

We are looking forward to the official launch of our school year, one week from today on Monday, August 17. Student Schedules

Our counselors have been working hard to polish student schedules. Over the past week, they have had a staggered system of opening up PowerSchool student portal access for grade levels to preview their schedules. We are opening the student portal in lieu of mailing hard copies of schedules to students. At this time, students of all grade levels can log into their PowerSchool Student Portal, and should check their student email for additional information from the counselors. Students who need to request a change should submit via the schedule change form that our counselors have emailed, and they will work to make the adjustments that they can prior to the first day of school.
