MRMS 1:1 Laptop Discipline Policy

- MRMS Policy 1: Students may not access chatting, social media, gaming, pornographic material, proxy, or other inappropriate websites prohibited in the acceptable use policy for Union County Public Schools. This includes using webcams and software for inappropriate activity as defined in the acceptable use policy. Offenses will be handled per UCPS Board of Education policy and the following:
 - -1st Offense: warning, parent contact
 - -2nd Offense: loss of issued student laptop (will need to check in and out each day), parent contact
 - -3rd Offense: loss of ability to utilize a UCPS laptop
- MRMS Policy 2: Students may not vandalize laptops, including intentional damage to hardware, altering computer settings, accessing/altering UCPS central network server files, installing appropriate software, or damaging another student's laptop.
 - -1st offense: MRMS computer technician or administration will take possession of laptop and evaluate damage. Student will lose laptop privileges for one week and serve after school detention. The student will also pay the cost of repairs.
 - -2nd offense: MRMS computer technician or administration will take possession of the laptop and evaluate damages. Loss of laptop privileges for the remainder of the semester and ISS or OSS assigned. Student will pay the cost of repairs.
- MRMS Policy 3: Theft of laptop or failure to return laptop to MRMS upon withdrawal, transfer, or at the end of the school year will result in the school resource officer being contacted by computer technician or administration to assist with recovery of laptop. Student may be responsible to pay replacement cost of lost/stolen laptop or computer accessories.
