Warrior Block

You may have noticed in the daily schedule listed earlier in this document that we will be implementing something called Warrior Block in the coming school year. This will be a period of time built into the school day when students can receive extra help from their teachers, complete late or missing assignments, and work with teachers to gain even deeper understanding of concepts that they've already mastered. Additionally, it will be an opportunity for students who meet certain qualifications to have a study hall during the day, meet with student club members, and even get some physical fitness during the school day.

Focus Areas with our WHS Students

As we embark on yet another school year, our students will be striving for strong grades in their courses, and we love that about our students. We certainly want to keep that reality in place, but we also ask all parents to join us in promoting and working to develop attributes in our students which are even more important to their current and future success. Those attributes are character, worth ethic, and the commitment to learn and grow each day. We strongly feel that if these are focus areas in our goals for our students, then we'll be providing a top notch learning environment while providing our students with lifelong gifts. If they've got high character, a strong work ethic, and a commitment to learning and growth, then the grades will indeed shake out as they should.

New Chromebooks

All UCPS high school students will be receiving new Chromebooks this school year. There will no longer be a UCPS technology fee for families for students as there has been in the past. Please instruct your child to leave the hard plastic cover on his/her machine, as if it is removed, the warranty will be voided, and families will become financially responsible for damage.

<u>IdentiKid</u>

A new visitor management system called IdentiKid is being used in all Union County Public Schools in the coming school year. In short, <u>any parent or other adult visitor who wishes to move beyond the main office on any day</u> <u>that school is in session will be required to have his or her driver's license scanned so that an immediate</u> <u>background check can be conducted.</u> This system is aimed at student safety, so we appreciate your patience with the extra minute or two that it may take you to move beyond our main office. In summary, please remember to bring your driver's license into the school with you when visiting at any time in which school is in session.

One to One Initiative

In the beginning of year student packets sent home with students, families were provided with a 1:1 Student/Parent Agreement form for students to receive a Chromebook. Some families picked up and completed this form at orientation. The form is also available on the WHS website in the Quick Links section. On September 4 and 5, students who have submitted their agreement forms may pick up their laptop devices from the media center. Students will be cued by last name during the instructional day on the closed circuit television system to pick up laptops in the media center. Students are reminded of the following:

- Do not put stickers of any kind on the Chromebook, and do not peel any labels off the Chromebook or charger. This includes student name labels and barcodes affixed by the school staff. The serial number of each piece of equipment can be traced back to each student, so they should never put on or take off a label or sticker.
- Students should bring their Chromebooks and chargers to school each day. There are not loaner chargers that students can borrow at school. Additionally, students are not guaranteed to get a loaner laptop should they leave their computers at home.
- Students will be required to pay for intentional damages to their Chromebook or damages which result from negligent behavior.
- If students should encounter problems with their Chromebooks, they may see our technology engineer, Ms. Tammy Douglas, before or after school or during their lunch. Ms. Douglas' office is adjacent to the media center, and she may be contacted at tammy.douglas@ucps.kl2.nc.us.
