2020-2021 Schedule Change

Choose best fit classes...a schedule change request in 2020-2021 will only be considered if students meet one of the following criteria:

1. Missing a graduation requirement
2. Hole/"Please see your Counselor" message on schedule
3. Would like to be placed in a less rigorous course (AP to Honors, Honors to CP)
4. Course needed for credit recovery
5. Did not earn credit for the prerequisites
6. Previously earned credit for the course
7. SPCC enrollment has been confirmed
