IMPORTANT REMINDERS

We are seeing an increased number of student drivers getting to school late. Parents, if your student drives to school or rides with another student, please remind them of the importance of getting to school on time each day. Students are expected to be in class by the time the 8:10am bell rings.

We have been notified by the elementary school that a number of students are parking in the elementary school parking lot. All student drop-offs in the morning and pick-ups at dismissal are to be done in the car rider line. **We also ask that all cars pull all the way down in the car**


