# Very Important Testing Reminders...

#### **Exam tips:**

- Be on time! The building is open to students at 7:15am each morning.
- Students must be in their testing locations by 8:15 a.m. Students arriving late will not be admitted to exams once testing has begun.
- As a reminder, final exams count as 25% of the overall semester grade. Attendance is very important.
- Students will need their laptops and their chargers each day and a calculator if taking an exam where it is permitted.
- All students are encouraged to get a good night's sleep each night and have a healthy breakfast each morning.
- ONLY students taking state EOC/CTE exams will report to school next week. All teacher made final exams will be taken at home (see below for more information).

All High schools will administer all non-state, teacher made exams virtually during the last five days of Fall semester (January 10-14, 2022). If a student needs a school-based resource (i.e. broadband Internet) to complete the teacher made exams, we will provide a testing environment oncampus for teacher made exams. Students who need to take a teacher made exam at school due to needing a school-based resource (i.e. broadband internet), are asked to please contact Assistant Principal and WHS testing coordinator, Mrs. Alanna Smith at <a href="mailto:alanna.smith@ucps.k12.nc.us">alanna.smith@ucps.k12.nc.us</a>.

All required state exams (EOC/CTE Exam) will be administered in person, on campus the day of the exam. Students do not have the option to take state exams virtually or at home.

This plan will allow high schools to utilize all staff members who will be needed to test students who have a state-required assessment (EOC/CTE Exam) during the state-required test window. In addition, students who are on campus for state testing during the week of January 10-14, 2022 **will be dismissed once all testing is complete and bus transportation will be provided at this time**. There will be no review sessions following dismissal each day. All exams will begin at 8:15am and will end at approximately 12:30pm – 1:00pm.

#### Midyear Transcript / Midyear Report Request

Not all colleges/universities require a midyear transcript/midyear report. Check your email, review admissions pages, and login to your college portals to identify if this documentation is required. Complete the <a href="Midyear Transcript/Midyear Report Request Form">Midyear Transcript/Midyear Report Request Form</a> for those schools requesting or requiring a midyear transcript/midyear report.

Once Semester 1 exams have concluded and grades are finalized, the District will load final Semester 1 transcripts. This process could take up to 3 days. Please allow 2 weeks for transcripts to be submitted.

Only midyear transcripts requested via this document will be sent to colleges/universities. Email/voicemail requests will not be processed. This form can also be found on the School Counseling webpage. Check your SCOIR account for updates.

## DIGITAL RESOURCE ACCESS FOR PARENTS

UCPS Technology Services has partnered with NCDPI to pilot the Single Sign-On (SSO) platform for parents and guardians using the existing NCEdCloud (<a href="https://my.ncedcloud.org">https://my.ncedcloud.org</a>) webpage. This new service is **optional** for parents however will provide a convenient one-stop access to digital resources such as Canvas, PowerSchool Parent Portal, Discovery Education, and local Clever applications.

Single Sign-On accounts using NCEdCloud will only be available for parents and guardians who currently have a PowerSchool Parent Portal account. On January 10, 2022, parents who have an existing PowerSchool Parent Portal account will receive notification of this new service via their PowerSchool Parent Portal email address. Once their Single SignOn account is configured by

NCEdCloud, they will receive an email indicating the Parent/Guardian account has been set up, along with a Claim Code and instructions on how to "Claim Your Account" at <a href="https://my.ncedcloud.org">https://my.ncedcloud.org</a>.

To claim an NCEdCloud Parent/Guardian account, parents will need the Claim Code received in the email, along with their email address. (Click here for overview and instructions). After the account has been claimed, parents will log into <a href="https://my.ncedcloud.org">https://my.ncedcloud.org</a> using the credentials established during the account claiming process to view and access the dashboard of digital resources.
