Final Exam Schedule

Attached to this Warrior Weekly email message is the 2018-2019 first semester final exam schedule for Weddington High School. After reviewing the information, please direct questions to your child, your child's teacher, a guidance counselor, or a school administrator.

Please note the following important information regarding exams:

-Review session attendance by students is required for the following: All EOC courses (English II, Math I, Math III, Biology), all NCFE courses (list available here:

http://www.ncpublicschools.org/docs/accountability/testing/common-exams/ncfecrsecdes18.pdf), and all courses with a teacher-made final exam unless a student has a cumulative grade of A or B in the class.

- -A student absence from a required review session will be treated as an unexcused absence.
- -Students and parents may review the disciplinary consequences for unexcused absences in the WHS student handbook which is available on our school website in the Parents & Students section.
- -Any student who is leaving campus early must follow the normal early dismissal procedure which includes submitting an early dismissal note from a parent or guardian to the main office prior to being picked up or driving home.
- -Students will not be permitted to leave exam periods early. Dismissal will occur at 12:30 for students not attending review sessions and at 2:30 for students who are attending review sessions.
