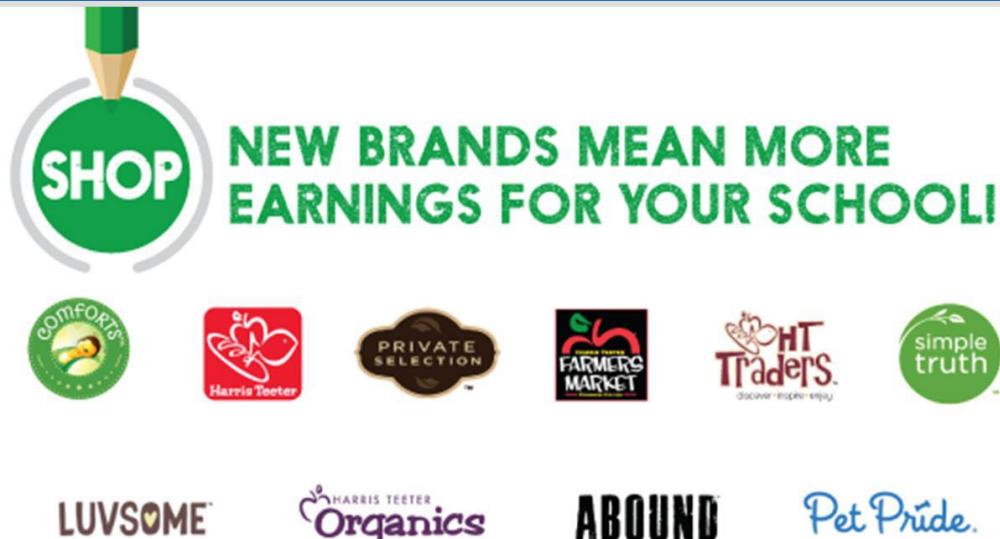
Scholarship Opportunity
