Union County Public Schools Career Readiness (formerly called Career and Technical Education) strives to provide a wide array of small, personalized learning communities within different high schools across the county. Rising Juniors and Seniors can apply for entrance into an academy pathway through a voluntary application process. At this time, students must also provide their own transportation if moving from one school to another for classes.

Academy options include the following: Veterinarian Assisting, Broadcasting, Digital Film Editing and Production, Culinary Arts, Early Childhood Education, Nurse Aid, Pharmacy Tech, Aviation, PLTW Engineering, Renewable Energy Engineering, Drafting, Automotive Repair, Carpentry, Collision Repair, Cosmetology, Electrical Trades, Fire Fighter, HVAC, Law and Justice, Masonry and Welding.

- -Important Dates:
 - *Week of March 4: counselors provide group academic advising for students during school day
 - *March 12: Registration Info Night for Parents (will include information about AP classes, Honors vs. CP decisions, etc.)
 - *March 15: PowerSchool registration portal opens for students/parents to input course selections
 - *March 18 April 15: Counselors meet with students for individual advising during school day

Current 9th – 11th grade students have been advised that their course selections for the 2019-2020 registration must be entered into PowerSchool by March 29th. The registration portal will not be open for inputting course selections after Friday, March 29th!
