UCPS Academic Plan

Please take note of the following important points regarding the Union County Public Schools plan for remote/digital teaching-and-learning:

- -The first day of new learning/instruction for UCPS high schools will be next Monday, May 30.
- -On Thursday and Friday of this week, WHS teachers will be participating in required professional development with a focus on teaching in a virtual environment.

- -Teaching-and-learning will consist of newly learned material and concepts, not just review of previously learned material.
- -We will share more detailed information later this week regarding teaching-and learning days and times, grades, attendance, meeting the needs of students with IEP's, 504's, and other specialized plans, and more.
- -For the remainder of this week, students are encouraged to continue to access optional review material through the UCPS EmpowerED Family Portal: https://www.ucps.k12.nc.us/domain/2917 and/or review material and resources which you've provided.
- -A student technology help/support hotline will be in operation soon. Details are forthcoming.

WHS Grounds and Athletic Complex Access
