## **Exam Exemption Policy Change**

At their March meeting, the UCPS Board of Education amended the portion of the student attendance policy which addresses high school teacher-made exam exemptions. The revised policy now reads as follows:

High School students will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:

- The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 2 unexcused absences in the class; or
- The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 1 unexcused absence in the class.

Teacher made tests are defined as tests designed and graded by a UCPS teacher of record for the purpose of assigning an exam grade to a student. Exam exemptions only apply to teacher made tests and are not available in courses which require the administration of an End of Course or state mandated final exams. Students enrolled in AP courses will still be required to take the AP exam. Students are expected to take all other assessments given at the school.

## Course Registration for 2019-2020 School Year

-Important Dates:

- \*Week of March 4: counselors provide group academic advising for students during school day
- \*March 12: Registration Info Night for Parents (will include information about AP classes, Honors vs. CP decisions, etc.)
- \*March 15: PowerSchool registration portal opens for students/parents to input course selections
- \*March 18 April 15: Counselors meet with students for individual advising during school day

Current 9<sup>th</sup> — 11<sup>th</sup> grade students have been advised that their course selections for the 2019-2020 registration must be entered into PowerSchool by March 29th. The registration portal will not be open for inputting course selections after Friday, March 29th!
