

Our WHS 9<sup>th</sup> graders recently took a survey which was designed to capture their perceptions regarding the transition to high school. The survey provided us with a great deal of data that we will use to continue to serve our transitioning freshmen, meet their needs, and make program improvements. One of the survey items is really worth celebrating because we believe that it reflects the healthy culture that we (students, staff, parents) have built together as a school community. That survey items is as follows:

-*Fellow students are accepting of me, even though I may be different from them*. 94.86% of our 9<sup>th</sup> grade students agreed with this statement. Again, we should celebrate this strong reflection of who we are as a school, and we should continue to instill in our young people the idea that student differences in interests, skill sets, and personalities help to make WHS a great place.

#### <u>Naviance</u>

Correspondence from the School Counseling department is often sent via Naviance. The most recent 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade message was about Newcomers Lunch. If this message was not delivered to you, it might mean that your parent contact information needs to be updated in Naviance. This update is quick and easy.

- 1. Ask your student to log into Naviance
- 2. Click on the About Me tab
- 3. Click on Surveys
- 4. Click on Surveys Not Completed
- 5. Click on and complete the WHS Parent Contact Info Update

**Parent Access:** Your student will have access to Naviance directly from his/her UCPS student start-up menu, but parents have to register with an access code to be able to view the available tools within your student's account. These access codes are only available to parents who have created a PowerSchool parent portal account. Please contact the School Counseling office to request your Naviance Parent Access Code. To register your account, please see the Parent Access Tutorial below and follow the simple 2-step process.

If you have not created a PowerSchool parent portal account, you may do so by contacting your student's counselor to obtain the necessary log in information. This will allow an access code to be generated for your account.
