# Weddington High School Leading the Way!

The Charlotte Business Journal recently released rankings for two academic performance indicators for public and charter schools in the Charlotte metro area (Cabarrus County, Gaston County, Iredell County, Mecklenburg County, and Union County). Data sets for the rankings were derived from the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. The first indicator ranking is college and career readiness, which was determined by student performance on end of course assessments in biology, English, and mathematics. Let's celebrate the fact that Weddington High School was ranked #1 of all comprehensive, traditional high schools (non-magnet schools) in this category. The second ranking is average ACT score. Let's also celebrate this one as Weddington High School ranked #1 of all Charlotte area public and charter schools with an average score of 24. These rankings should

make us proud as they reflect the collective commitment to excellence which is the cornerstone of our school's success and which characterizes the daily work of our students, staff members, and parents. Here are links to the two articles:

## **Pre-ACT Test**

All sophomores are required to participate in the Pre-ACT test on October 24<sup>th</sup> at Weddington High School. This test is designed to help students with the following:

- Identifying current academic readiness for college and career using the Pre-ACT score report
- Predicting performance on the ACT after an additional year of learning
- Determining skills which can be improved based on performance
- Exploring how career aspirations align with personal interests
- Overall great practice in preparing for the ACT test

If students normally receive testing accommodations, they will also receive their accommodations on Pre-ACT test day. All testing will take place on E-Hall, and students will be informed of their testing locations by their teachers and by rosters located around the building. All class absences resulting from testing will be excused. 


