The School Counseling Summary

(News and Notes from the WHS Guidance Office)

It's never too early to start saving for college. As cliché as it may sound, no truer words were spoken. For most students applying to college, the possibility of attending begins with completing the FAFSA (https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa). Financial aid is a way of life. Dreams become reality when grant money is awarded, loans are distributed, and scholarships are earned. Finding scholarships may seem like a daunting task. Searching will take time, however, nothing worth fighting for was ever easy. Five of the most popular scholarship search engines include the following:

Additionally, students can be matched to 3.5 million scholarships worth more than \$18 billion by simply completing the Scholarship Search tool in Naviance. Simply use the WHS student login or login via https://student.naviance.com/main and enter the WHS zip code (28104) to generate the WHS login page. Once logged into the WHS student Naviance account, click on the "College" found at the top right corner, scroll down and click on "Scholarships and Money" to start the linking process.

Not sure where to begin? Check in with your School Counselor. Freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors... start planning today for your educational tomorrow.

PSAT

The PSAT will be offed to WHS students on October 16, 2019.

Sophomores are required to take the exam and are automatically registered for the test at no cost to the student.

Juniors are encouraged to test as junior year is the only year applicable to National Merit Scholarship. *Freshman* are encouraged to test if the student is enrolled in Math II or will be enrolled in the Spring.

PSAT scores are never submitted to colleges, and this is great practice for a timed test.

Freshman and Junior students will be charged a test fee of \$25 and can pay cash or checks made payable to WHS. Please submit payment in the School Counseling office to Mrs. Washington.

Absences from class will be excused if a student is participating in testing. Test spots are limited, so please sign up quickly
