ACT Information for Juniors

Scores are now available through students online account for Juniors who took the school based ACT test on March 1st. Scores for students who took the ACT on a makeup day or with accommodations have NOT been released and could take several more weeks.

If a student did not use the handout provided during pre-administration to set up their account or to merge their existing account, they will need to contact ACT directly. Typically, ACT will not discuss test details with a parent as they require the student to call.

ACT can be contacted directly at 1-319-337-1270. You will also need to provide the date you tested (March 1st) as well as date of birth. Please do not use your student email as ACT can't email a student account.
