Warrior Block

Perhaps you've heard your child talk about Warrior Block at WHS. Here are some of the most important points about Warrior Block:

- *It occurs each school day from approximately 9:30 a.m. 10:00 a.m.
- *It is connected to school classes as follows: Monday-period 1, Tuesday-period 2, Wednesday-period 3, Thursday-period 4; On Fridays, all students report to homeroom.
- *Students report to Warrior Block classes according to the schedule above to receive academic remediation, extension, tutoring, test preparation, make-up work, etc.
- *If a student has a grade of 90+ (85+ for AP classes) in the assigned Warrior block class for the day and has no missing assignments in the class, then he/she is exempt and may select a "choice area" during Warrior Block. Choice areas include the following: silent study hall, collaborative study hall, gym time (grades 10-12 only), club/student group work, peer tutoring other students in Warrior Block classes.
- *Guidance services and programs are also offered during Warrior Block.

A message from our Guidance Department chairperson, Dr. Mary Jordan:

On the backside of a ripped brown paper bag and with a black permeant magic marker, my dad wrote words spoken by famous American actress, comedian, writer, and producer, Lily Tomlin, "The road to success is always under construction." He snagged a piece of tape from my study space, taped the wisdom filled sentiment above the cream-colored doorframe, walked over to share one final hug, and walked out of my college dorm room with tears streaming down his face.

This August marked 25 years since that emotion-filled teachable moment. The words have helped to lead the way when things have become more than I thought I could handle, when I wanted to give up, when the next step seemed too steep...words that have guided each in my life.

Like the transition from high school to college can pose challenges, the transition from middle school to high school for some students (and guardians) is seamless. However, for other students, the road is full of deep potholes, rides a bit like being on a rollercoaster, and is spotted with peaks and valleys. This week, some of the

new students to the Weddington cluster have popped in and out of the School Counseling office experiencing a sense of disconnect. Students seek assistance in lunchroom anxiety, juggling homework, choosing a college, becoming organized, and learning new technologies. The Newcomers Lunch scheduled for Thursday, September 19th, 2019 will allow the School Counselors facilitating the discussion to address the transitional topics noted above and much more. Please know that even if your student is not new to the WHS cluster, but you nonetheless feel that participating in the lunch would provide social/emotional support for your child, please don't hesitate to reach out via email to mary.jordan@ucps.k12.nc.us. An email to sign up for the luncheon will be shared on Monday, September 16th.
