

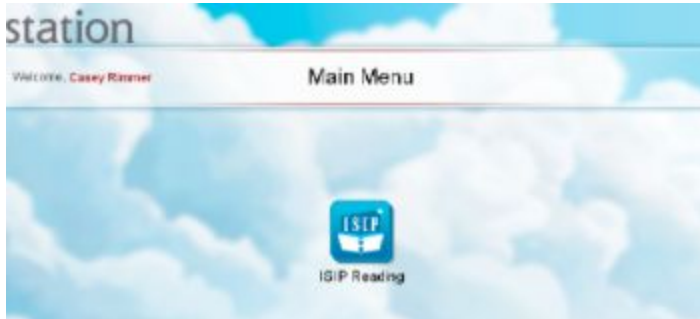
## 4th Grade Istation Parent Information

Due to the unique circumstances at the end of last school year and leading into the 2020-2021 school year, 4th grade students are required under Read to Achieve legislation to take a Read to Achieve make up test within the first ten days of school. In UCPS this is going to be the Istation ISIP screener.

It is recommended that students take the assessment on the UCPS issues chromebook as there are extra steps involved for those using their own devices.

To log in, follow the directions sent from your school called "UCPS Directions for Home Access to Istation".

Your child will click on "ISIP Reading" to take the assessment.



### Best Practices for Testing:

- Provide a quiet location free of distractions.
- Schedule the assessment at a time of the day when your child is rested. This is usually in the morning.
- Allow your child to complete the assessment independently, without help. This information will provide the teacher with important information about what your child knows and what they need to learn.
- Inform your child that the assessment will take 20-30 minutes and will have four short tests. (It is not required that students finish the assessment in one sitting.)
- Encourage him/her to do their best.

When you see the ISIP in progress button at the bottom of the screen this means that your child is taking the assessment. Once the ISIP in progress button goes away, your child is no longer in assessment mode.



Headphones are not required, but are recommended to ensure your child can hear the assessment clearly. As the test is timed, be sure to check with your child at the beginning of the assessment to make sure he/she can hear.
