

## **HEARING SCREENING / VISION SCREENING**

Dear Parents/Guardians of 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Students,

Because hearing and vision are both important to your child's ability to learn and progress in school, Union County Public Schools will be providing mass hearing and vision screenings for all 7<sup>th</sup> graders across the county. Our hearing and vision screening day at Marvin Ridge Middle School has been scheduled for **Tuesday, November 6th**. We will be screening all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students that day in the media center. If your child wears glasses, please be sure they have their glasses with them on Tuesday, November 6th.

Any student who has possible hearing problems noted during this screening process will be seen in approximately 4-6 weeks by the school audiologist. If your child has ANY problems at the time of this re-screening, the audiologist will send a letter home notifying you of the results and actions you should take. Therefore, **NO** paperwork home means that your child passed the hearing screening.

For vision screening, any child who has possible vision problems noted during the screening will have a letter sent home through the mail for follow-up recommendations to your eye care professional for a rescreen.
