Protocol

Stock Albuterol Use in the Schools

- 1. Albuterol will be stocked in each school. Prescriptions will be purchased by each school individually.
- 2. Stock Albuterol may be administered only by the School Nurse.
- 3. The use of stock Albuterol should occur ONLY when a student with the diagnosis of asthma has forgotten their own inhaler. It is not the intent of the schools to provide daily/routine meds for students with asthma, but to offer students/parents an emergency supply. If this privilege is abused the school nurse will counsel with parent/guardian about having a "back up" inhaler in the school medicine cabinet. The number of "stock inhaler uses" to be designated as abuse will be decided as a site-based decision.
- 4. There must be a current completed medication consent form for Albuterol signed by both the parent and the medical provider on file for Albuterol to be given.
- Stock Albuterol may not be administered to any student without a confirmed diagnosis of asthma and a current signed medication consent on file.
- 6. The school nurse will use paper or disposable spacer to reduce chance of contamination of metered dose inhaler.
- 7. After use, the inhaler should be cleaned well with soap and water, then alcohol and air-dried.
- 8. If a student is experiencing asthma related symptoms and does not have a current medication consent, have the student to rest, drink water, relax and notify parent. If symptoms worsen, call 911. See Treatment of Status Asthmaticus with Epinephrine if needed.

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
