Course Recommendations/Waiver Forms

Students are advised to take teacher recommendations seriously. Teacher recommendations are required for honors & AP level courses. Keep in mind that honors & AP level courses require both high academic ability in the subject area & a strong work ethic. However, a student is not required to register per these recommendations. Waiver forms are used only to register for a higher level course than was recommended by your teacher. Waiver forms are available in the Counseling Office and must be signed by a parent & brought to registration.

AP Courses

AP courses are rigorous, college level courses. Note that if you were recommended for an AP course and choose not to take the course you will have the opportunity to discuss your options & change the course selection when you meet with a counselor.

Career & College Promise

Rising Juniors & Seniors have the opportunity to take college courses through SPCC for free. Students must have a 3.0 GPA & qualifying test scores for most of the courses. General college transfer courses are available in subject areas such as English, Math, Social Sciences, Humanities, etc. Students can also take Career & Technical classes which include areas such as Criminal Justice, Game Design, Health Sciences, Business, etc. Ask a counselor for more information & let them know at registration.

INFO FOR RISING SENIORS

Early Graduation Forms

- Located in the Counseling Office.
- Must be signed by a counselor and your parent(s).
- Form must be filled out and brought to registration.
- When registering select **four 1st choice classes and two alternates.**

Flex Day Applications

- Located in the Counseling Office.
- Must be signed by a parent.
- Form must be filled out and brought to registration.
- Flex day will be approved primarily for 2nd semester (1st semester will be on a case by case basis).

Peer Tutor Forms

- Located in the Counseling Office.
- Form must be filled out and brought to registration.
- Pay close attention to the requirements needed to be a Peer Tutor.
- Peer Tutors will be approved and assigned at a later date.
