What is the purpose of the AVID binder?

Organization is an important skill in school, career and other aspects of daily life. The AVID binder is an organizational tool to help students maintain notes and school work in one place. Students are expected to maintain a binder, which has been organized along with all of the necessary items such as pencil pouch, agenda, and dividers. They are expected to keep it organized using the AVID methods they have been taught. These notebooks may look different across the 3-5 grades but the purpose is the same- to create a strong desire for success by maintaining organized work materials. Please take time each day to talk to your child about what they are doing in class. Sign their agenda daily and encourage them to return all binders, agendas, folders and reading logs to school daily.
